

# Safe Reopening of Schools

Federal COVID-19 relief programs – including the CARES Act – provide funding to help schools safely reopen their doors to in-person learning. The availability and use of these funds are left to the discretion of each state's department of education. In general, funding is for:

- K-12 schools
- Higher education institutions
- Purchase of "supplies to sanitize and clean the facilities of a local educational agency"<sup>1</sup>
- "Providing principals and others school leaders with the resources necessary to address the needs of their individual schools"<sup>1</sup>



New CDC recommendations to schools include building time into daily routines for students and staff to wash hands. Make sure you have enough hand soap in stock!
