Antibacterial hand soaps kill the most common bacteria that cause disease.



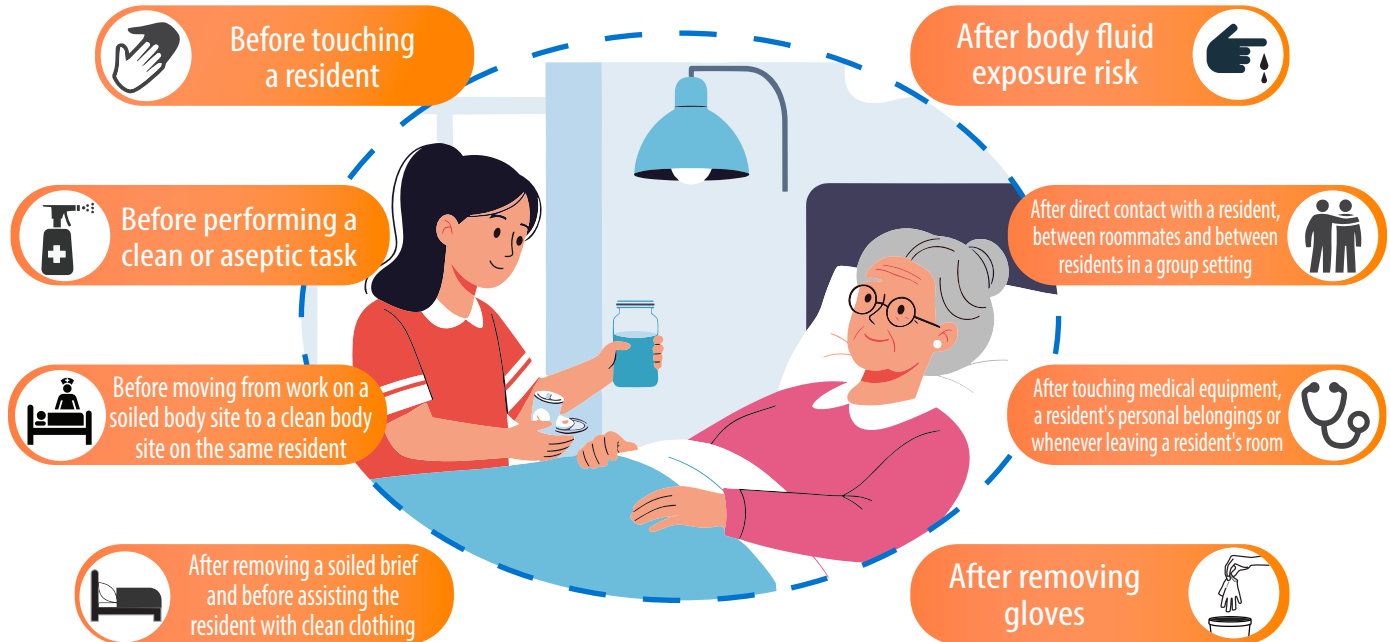
