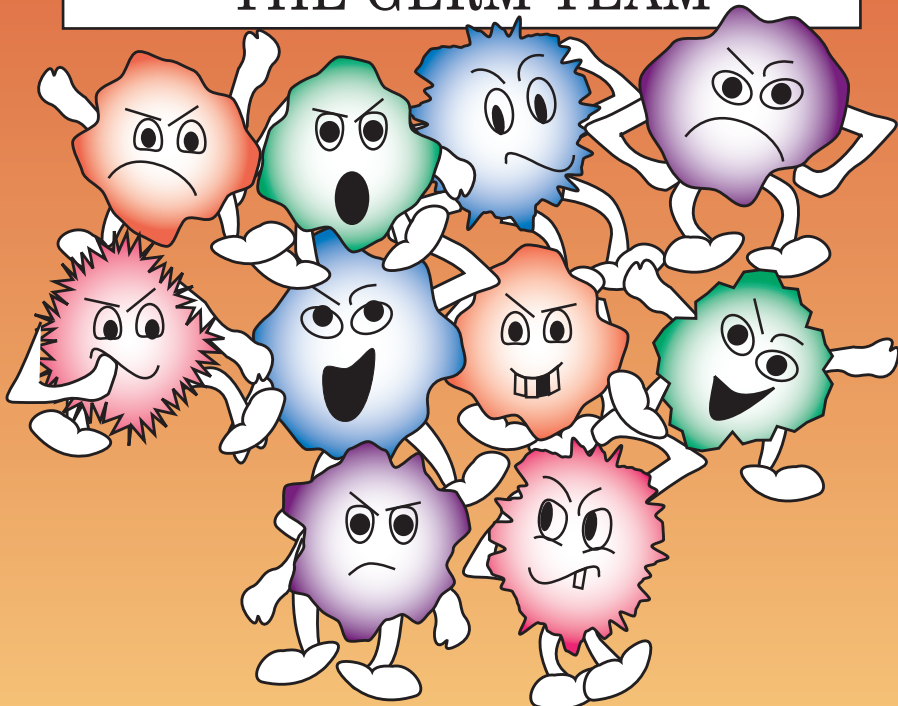

| BACK ROW: | Shigella
Can cause bad diarrhea | Pneumococcus
Can cause pneumonia, ear infections, sinusitis and meningitis | Hepatitis
Can cause jaundice and diarrhea | Haemophilus aegyptius
Can cause pinkeye |
| MIDDLE ROW: | Giardia
Can cause diarrhea | Streptococcus
Can cause a bad sore throat | Haemophilus Influenzae
Can cause bacterial meningitis and respiratory infection | Pseudomonas
Can infect open cuts |
| FRONT ROW: | E-Coli
Can cause stomach pain, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting | Staphylococcus
Can cause a skin infection and pimples | | |
